Course Materials:

We will confirm your registration by email. Pre-course Information with your username and password for access to the mandatory online examination will be sent to you upon receipt of your completed online registration request. Course registration is not confirmed until you have RECEIVED THE CONFIRMATION EMAIL. If you do not receive an email within 2 business days after submitting your online registration, please contact the Life Support Training Center at (856) 342-2009. It is suggested that all participants read the NRP Provider Manual (7th edition) prior to starting the mandatory online examination. This manual is available for purchase from the LSTC for \$70.00. Course Description:

The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) is an educational program jointly sponsored between the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and the American Heart Association (AHA). The NRP course conveys an evidence-based approach to care of the newborn at birth and facilitates effective team-based care for healthcare professionals who care for newborns at the time of delivery. NRP utilizes a blended learning approach, which includes online testing, online case-based simulations, and hands-on case-based simulation/debriefing that focuses on critical leadership, communication, and team-work skills.

Intended Audience:

The intended audience for this course includes pediatricians, emergency physicians, nurses, paramedics, respiratory therapists, and other healthcare professionals who may be involved in the first critical moments of a newborn infant's life. The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) course format requires learners to self-study the material from the <u>Textbook of</u> <u>Neonatal Resuscitation</u>, 7th edition, and take a mandatory online examination <u>**BEFORE**</u> attending their NRP course.

Prerequisites:
