Premier Institutes



MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper

Through a partnership with the nation's leading cancer center, MD Anderson Cancer Center at Cooper provides access to MD Anderson's proven treatment plans, specialized cancer expertise, innovative technologies, cutting-edge clinical trials, and collaboration with national and regional cancer specialists. MD Anderson at Cooper takes a multidisciplinary team approach to cancer care. The team provides each patient with a customized treatment plan and comprehensive support services. No one fights cancer alone.



Cooper Heart Institute/Cardiac Partners

In a joint venture, cardiac experts from the Cooper Heart Institute and Inspira Health provide a full range of heart care services and the most innovative nonsurgical and surgical treatments. Our Structural Heart Program—the first of its kind in the region—pioneers new devices and minimally invasive and catheter-based procedures to treat heart tissues and valves. Cooper's renowned clinical and interventional cardiologists perform more cardiothoracic surgeries than any other team in the region.



Cooper Neurological Institute

The Cooper Neurological Institute (CNI) is dedicated to diagnosing and treating neurological and neurosurgical issues, including epilepsy, movement disorders, headache, and trauma as well as brain, spine, and pituitary cancer. Cooper's Stroke Program was the first in South Jersey to receive The Joint Commission's Advanced Certification as a Comprehensive Stroke Center. By using artificial intelligence, our experts have accelerated recovery and set new standards across the entire spectrum of neurosciences.



Surgical Services Institute

Cooper's Surgical Services Institute performs more than 27,000 surgeries each year, offering advanced treatment options in 12 specialty areas, including ear, nose, and throat; colorectal; general; plastic and reconstructive; oral and maxillofacial; thoracic; urologic; and vascular. It is also home to the Cooper Aortic Center, the Bariatric and Metabolic Surgery Center, the Level I Adult Trauma Center, and the only Pediatric Trauma Center in South Jersey.

Premier Institutes



Adult Health Institute

The Adult Health Institute provides an extensive network of coordinated primary and specialty care services, including dermatology and dermatologic surgery, endocrinology, family medicine, geriatric medicine, infectious disease, internal medicine, nephrology, palliative care, and pulmonary medicine. The Cooper Digestive Health Institute provides a full range of gastrointestinal services with three full-service endoscopy centers in South Jersey.



Cooper Bone and Joint Institute

The Cooper Bone and Joint Institute is South Jersey's premier academic musculoskeletal center, offering high-quality orthopaedic care with the latest technological advances. The integrated team includes fellowship-trained and board-certified experts in orthopaedics, rheumatology, podiatry, and rehabilitation for arthritis pain, sprains, and strains, tendon or ligament injury, tendonitis, broken bones, dislocations, trauma, and more.



Women's and Children's Institute

The Women's and Children's Institute is home to the Children's Regional Hospital at Cooper, South Jersey's only state-designated hospital for children, offering 27 pediatric subspecialties. Women's health care services include obstetrics and gynecology, maternal-fetal medicine, urogynecology, and the Ripa Center for Women's Health and Wellness at Cooper, which provides primary and multispecialty care, radiology services, and wellness education.



Urban Health Institute

The Urban Health Institute is redesigning health care to meet the needs of an underserved population. Its founding principle is to ensure that community residents have access to quality preventive care and the tools to manage complex medical conditions. This institute includes the Cooper Advanced Care Center, with primary care and medical and surgical specialties, and the Camden Coalition of Healthcare Providers, whose key role is knowledge dissemination and communication among organizations in Camden.

Centers of Excellence

Center for Critical Care Services

The Center for Critical Care Services provides the highest level of lifesaving inpatient care for seriously ill and injured patients. The Center is staffed by physician experts in sepsis, cardiogenic shock, and respiratory failure.

Center for Urgent and Emergent Services

Cooper's Center for Urgent and Emergent Services provides 24/7 access to immediate care, whether through the emergency department, 911 emergency medical services, disaster medicine, air medical services, or the transfer center. Cooper's Urgent Care Centers are staffed by expert, board-certified Emergency Medicine physicians and offer extended day, evening, and weekend hours for patients of all ages.

Center for Population Health

Cooper's Center for Population Health aims to implement new care strategies to improve patient experience and reduce costs without cutting or rationing services. One of the key components of Population Health aims to anchor patients to a medical home generally located in a primary care physician's office. Another is to focus on the highest users of health care, those with chronic or multiple conditions who need regular monitoring, from nutrition counseling to home visits, and to keep them out of the hospital.

Center for Trauma Services

The Center for Trauma Services is a Level I Adult Trauma Center and Level II Pediatric Trauma Center that cares for severely injured patients involved in motor vehicle crashes, falls, industrial accidents, and acts of violence. It offers an active community education program in trauma prevention and safety. Cooper is the only hospital in the region that provides trauma care for adults and children.

Recovery Village Cherry Hill at Cooper

The Recovery Village Cherry Hill at Cooper offers a full continuum of inpatient and outpatient rehab services to address substance abuse and co-occurring mental health conditions. Skilled staff ensure patient safety with a focus on each individual's specific needs and the facility exceeds local and national standards for addiction and behavioral health care practices.

Premier Training Center for the Military

Cooper Trauma and Emergency Medicine experts provide on-site training to elite special operations combat medics from the U.S. Military's Special Operations Command and medical personnel with the U.S. Department of State Emergency Management Specialists. Cooper's trauma center is the busiest in the region and was the first in the nation to provide advanced surgical trauma training to the U.S. Army's elite Forward Resuscitation Surgical Team (FRST).



Research

Cooper is at the forefront of driving and delivering scientific and technological innovation to advance patient care. As the region's leading academic health system, Cooper's medical and bioscience research programs help develop the next generation of breakthrough treatments and cures. Cooper's research endeavors recently received a \$50 million commitment from Rowan University to further expand our already robust and collaborative research program.

The Cooper Research Institute fosters research by providing the faculty, residents, fellows, nurses, and allied health professionals with the support and services they need to promote, develop and conduct investigator-initiated and sponsor-initiated clinical research, and to attract and manage government, foundation, and industry support.
